

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF DISABLED OR JUNKED AUTOMOBILES UPON ANY PUBLIC STREET OR THOROUGHFARE OR UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF ACKERMAN, MISSISSIPPI, UNLESS THE SAME SHALL BE AN AUTOMOBILE JUNK YARD MAINTAINED, FENCED, AND SCREENED AS REQUIRED BY THE ORDINANCES OF SAID TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF ACKERMAN, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. The parking, leaving, or abandonment of any disabled or junked automobile on the public streets or elsewhere on any property situated within the corporate limits of the Town of Ackerman is hereby prohibited unless the same shall be upon a properly fenced and screened automobile junk yard as required by the Ordinances of said Town.

SECTION 2. Any automobile incapable of being driven or operated on its own power shall be a disabled or junked automobile within the meaning of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Ackerman, Mississippi, acting by and through any municipal employee, shall have the authority to remove such junked or disabled automobile from any thoroughfare or public street in said Town or from any other location which renders said vehicle an unsightly object or a public nuisance and shall assess the cost of such removal to the owner of the vehicle and may collect the same by any method authorized by law.

SECTION 4. Any person who parks, leaves, or abandons any such disabled or junked automobile upon any public thoroughfare or street within the corporate limits of the Town of Ackerman or who shall leave, abandon, or store the same at any location so as to render the vehicle an unsightly object or public nuisance shall be guilty of a violation of this Ordinance and may be punished within the limits prescribed by law for the violation of municipal ordinances.

SECTION 5. For good cause shown this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, it being the purpose of this Ordinance that the practice of leaving, abandoning, or maintaining junked automobiles on the public streets or at any other place rendering such vehicle an unsightly object or a public nuisance not hereafter permitted.
